

# COACH A Accredited by International Coaching Federation As Level 2 Program Provider

TOKYO, February 15, 2023 - COACH A Co., Ltd. announced that it was accredited as a Level 2 program provider under the new accreditation system of the International Coaching Federation (ICF) on January 31, 2023.

### **About ICF-accredited Programs**

ICF-accredited programs are recognized worldwide as high quality, specialized coach training programs that meet the numerous requirements established by ICF.

Launched in 1997 by COACH A (then known as the Coach Training Program [CTP]), coachAcademia (pronounced COACH A Academia), became the first ICF-accredited program in the Japanese language in October 1999.

### New Accreditation System Launched in January 2022

As the demand for coaching grows around the world, ICF has undergone several organizational and systemic reforms in recent years. Launched in January 2022, its new accreditation system is one such example.

One characteristic of the new system is that while previously individual training programs were accredited, the new system accredits the entire organization providing the training program. The application for accreditation under the new system needs to meet various standards and requirements such as the mission of the organization as a whole and the objectives for providing coach training programs. The new system demands greater accountability from the entire organization.

In addition, as the numbers of individuals and organizations providing coaching services increases worldwide, the need to ensure coaching quality has arisen. Against this backdrop, the new system includes stricter accreditation requirements than in the past.

A transition period of one year is allowed for previously accredited training programs to migrate to the new system. COACH A was accredited on January 31 of this year as an organization that satisfies the requirements of the new accreditation system.



# About ICF Level 2 Accreditation

The Level 2 accreditation is granted to organizations that provide programs with 125-175 hours of training that meet the requirements for the ICF Professional Certified Coach (PCC) credential. In the case of coachAcademia, there has been no change between before and after ICF Level 2 accreditation in terms of conditions, such as the credentials that trainees can earn.
